Entrance Location for Participants/Spectators: Spectators will enter through the main doors. Signs will be posted. Participants and coaches will enter through the team entrance. Coaches should have a preplanned meeting area to meet with younger participants. Please allow plenty of time for parking. American Cheer & Dance is not responsible for missed performance times.

** The facility will not open any earlier than the designated time. Please remain in your vehicle if you arrive early to the facility. Bathroom facilities will not be available until the facility is open.*

Venue Concessions: Concessions will be available for purchase.

Performance Order: A tentative order of performance will be posted on our website on Monday, March 7th after 5:00 PM. The order in which a team performs is chosen by random order. Teams with cross over participants may have to bear the burden of conflicting warm-up times. Once the performance times have been posted there will be no division or level changes. The final schedule will be posted on our website on Wednesday **March 9th** after 5 pm.

Registration Times: Specific team registration times will be posted on the final schedule. Directors may register all of their teams at the first designated time if they prefer. Please do not bring participants to the registration table. Any balances must be paid by cashiers check, money order or cash. Organization checks will not be accepted. Any or all outstanding medical release forms will be due at this time.

Any changes made the day of the event, only if approved by American Cheer & Dance Senior Staff, will be subject to a \$200.00 administrative fee.

Coaches Meeting: It is highly advisable that at least one coach/director attends the coaches meeting. Coaches meeting times will be posted on the final schedule. Please check with the registration staff for specific location.

Main Floor & Warm-up Areas: Cheer & Dance teams will compete on a 54'x 42' spring floor. Each team will have a designated time to warm-up their tumbling and their team performance. A tumble track and a standard cheer floor will be provided for warm-ups. Please check in at the warm-up area at least 10 minutes prior to your scheduled warm-up time. You **will not** be escorted.

Cross Over Policies: American Cheer & Dance allows cheer and dance participants to perform for more than one team and/or additional performances. Each participant will pay full registration fee for the first performance and \$28 for each performance thereafter. Individual and/or small group fees are additional and not considered as flip-flop or crossover performances. Registration forms must denote all flip flop/crossover information and payment. American Cheer & Dance Academy will do its best to allow time in between performances **but cannot guarantee the same for warm-up times.**

Spotters: ACDA may not be providing spotters at this event. If necessary, teams may supply their own spotters. Team spotters must be dressed appropriately and follow all safety guidelines (example: no jewelry, no gum, proper tennis shoes and clothing. Penalties may be assessed for spotters who are not in accordance with all safety rules).

Rules & Time Limits:

All Star Teams will follow the USASF rules & guidelines

School and Rec teams will follow US Finals rules & guidelines

All Dance teams will follow the US Finals rules & guidelines for dance

The max time limit for all cheer and dance routines is two minutes, thirty seconds (2:30)

** Dance teams may request more time for performances, please note any dance teams performing at US Finals will not be allowed this courtesy.*

Music/DJ: Music can be on CD (in the CDR format only) or on an MP3 player. Music should be recorded at medium volume. The music should stop at the end of the musical portion of your routine. **PLEASE label all CDs with the team/organization information. Be sure to have backup copies of your music, as well.**

A coach or team representative must report to the music table when your team/organization is called by the announcer to the 'on deck' area. This representative must stay at the DJ station throughout your team's routine and is responsible for stopping and starting the music. To avoid any problems, teams should bring two CD's (original and back up) to the music table.

Legality Verification: It is the coach's responsibility to be current on all level and safety guidelines. If you have questions concerning any legality please videotape the stunt or element in question and send to American Cheer & Dance home office at least two weeks prior to the event. Videos can also be emailed to rules@acdaspirt.com. Legalties will not be reviewed the day of the event.

First Aid: American Cheer & Dance will not provide trainers for this event. EMT services will be on site for medical emergencies.

Awards/Giveaways: Team Trophies: All teams will receive a team trophy. Teams will be placed out 1st thru 5th place. Honorable mention trophies will be awarded to teams who do not place. A Judge's choice award will be presented to a team who shows, not necessarily the highest score, but to the team who presents Great Spirit, sportsmanship and use of choreography. All participants will receive a drawstring championship backpack.



US Finals: Teams placing 1st- 5th place will be eligible to compete for the title of U.S. Champion at any of the US Finals events. Placement as well as free registration bids will be awarded at this event. Visit www.theusfinals.com for more information.

Score Sheets: Score sheets will be available the day of the event after the awards ceremonies.

Refund Policy: No refunds will be permitted within 3 weeks of the event.
